- automatically read and understand some high frequency words.

Alphabet Walk



1. Go for a walk outside and find things that start with each letter of the alphabet: A – ant, B – blue sky, C – car, D – door, etc.
2. Say each letter or sound aloud as you find each object.
3. Work your way through the whole alphabet. For tricky letters like Q, X, make up a word if you are stuck!
4. You can do this game inside as well, walking around the house to find items beginning with the sounds of the letters of the alphabet.
