Letters and Words Everywhere



1. Look through junk mail, flyers, old magazines or newspapers to find letters, sounds or words your child knows.
2. Circle these with a marker.
3. Look together to find, name, and circle new letters, sounds or words.
4. If you have scissors, you or your child can cut out the words and try to make a sentence!



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
