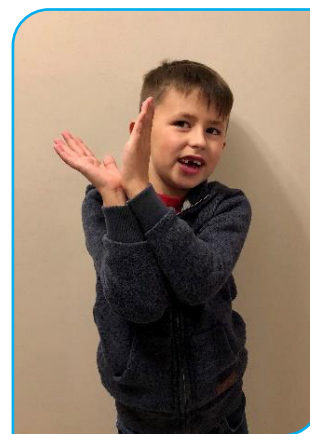
This activity provides opportunities to

- develop a knowledge of the letters of the alphabet including the sounds they make.
- automatically read and understand some high frequency words.
- develop control of large muscles.
- develop spatial awareness when using large muscles.
- participate in creative movement.

Move Like the Letter or Word



1. Work as partners.
2. Pick a few letters or words that your child knows and a few that they need to learn.
3. Take turns picking a letter or word. Act out the word or make your body into the shape of the letter.
4. Your partner should try to guess what letter or word you are showing.
5. For example, if your word is 'eat', you might pretend that you are eating something. If your letter is T you might make your body into a T shape.
